**Proposed Minutes**

**Call to Order:** Supervisor Mark Nunn called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. Also present were Clerk Bob White, and Trustee Cheri Mioduch. Treasurer Steve Ferguson and Trustee Mary Pingot were absent. Also present were Elections Clerk Gary Mallon and Cemetery Sexton Deb Mioduch. There were no others.
