Wilber Township—Iosco County Board of Trustees <u>Special</u> Meeting Regarding Groundskeeping March 24, 2022 Proposed Minutes

<u>Call to Order</u>: Supervisor Nunn called the meeting to order at 9:05 am.

Roll was called. Also present were Clerk Robert White, and Trustees Cheri Mioduch and Mary Pingot. Treasurer Steve Ferguson was absent. Also present was Cemetery Sexton Deb Mioduch.

Unfinished Business

New Business:

Discuss compensation for grounds maintenance at the Wilber Township Cemetery and the Township Hall.

The Cemetery Sexton stated that the tasks to be performed are too much for one individual, and requested an increase in the current compensation by \$500 in order to hire someone to help. In order to do that the sexton would have to be considered the employer, when in fact it would have be the township, and there are tax and liability issues that would then come into play.

Generally, the board members present acknowledges that the current compensation level is inadequate, given the level of care and responsibility, and the timing of same. The current amount is \$4,000 plus an additional \$500 for the spring cleanup. The sexton stated that while the spring cleanup is busy, it is really the fall when the intensity increases with the volume of downed leaves.

Moved by White, seconded by Nunn, to increase the compensation as follows: an additional \$100 per month, and \$500 in the spring and an additional \$500 in the fall, for a total of \$5,600.

A roll call vote was taken: Pingot, C. Mioduch, Nunn and White all voted aye, no nays and one absence. Motion carried
