Call to Order: Supervisor Nunn called the meeting to order at 9 AM.

Roll was called. Also present were Clerk Robert White, Treasurer Steve Ferguson and Trustee Sally Krueger. Trustee Mary Pingot was absent. There were no others present.

New Business:

Unfinished Business: Proposed (Big) Island Lake Weed Control/Muck Petition Language

The purpose of this special meeting is to discuss how to proceed relative to property owners' concerns about solutions to the condition of the (Big) Island Lake (the lake also has properties located in Plainfield Township).

The Supervisor has discussed the dual issues of weeds and muck with Savin Lake Services, who recommend a Biobase survey prior to any decisions relative to treatment options.

Treatments that include muck mitigation are more costly than for just weed control, and the estimate for both has been determined to be \$225/parcel for the 93 Parcels in Wilber Township (Plainfield has 24 parcels which would be affected).

Discussion as to what the muck treatment involves (essentially dissolving it through chemical means), and how do we know if the treatment is effective (Biobase survey, pre- and post- will indicate that).

Petition language was reviewed, and some minor adjustments to it and the formatting were recommended.

Moved by Krueger, seconded by Ferguson to approve the petition language as amended. All ayes, motion carried.

Finalized copies of the petitions will be delivered to those residents on the lake who want to start circulation them beginning this weekend.

Moved by Krueger to adjourn the meeting at 9:15.
