

### **Mark Nunn, Supervisor**

Mark is the Wilber Township supervisor, having been appointed by the Township Board of Trustees on March 4, 2013 after the retirement of then supervisor Howard Alverson. Prior to his appointment, he was the township's Deputy Supervisor, and served on the township planning commission and the assessing board of review.

Mark is a graduate of Ferris State University, where he majored in Business and Small Business Management.

He is self-employed in the lumber industry as a sawyer and provider of raw lumber to sawmills and wood products manufacturers.
