### **Mark Nunn, Supervisor**

Mark is the Wilber Township supervisor, having been appointed by the Township Board of Trustees on March 4, 2013. Prior to his appointment, he was the Deputy Supervisor and served on the Planning Commission and Assessing Board of Review. He has won re-election in 2016 and 2020.
